

News from Aberdeen FareShare

FareShare Aberdeen is going well.

We have recruited a number of new volunteers which is great and we are just about to put them through a number of training courses including Maunual Handling, Food Hygiene and looking ahead to Ffirst Aid.

A number of volunteers have also expressed interest in the "Confidence to Cook" course which we will be organising in the Spring.

We are still not quite into our new premises but we hope this will not be far away. Between CFINE and FareShare we are now seriously struggling for space so the sooner the move happens the better. This will allow significant growth and expansion for FareShare and will allow us to receive more deliveries and of course even more milk once we can afford more refrigeration.

Wiseman's continues to deliver on a regular basis and we still get our supplies via Dundee to keep us going.

Distribution has increased by approx 50% since this time last year and we are on target to meet our goal of 50 tonnes by the end of March this year which has been great for Aberdeen.

We have just recently applied to the Climate Challenge Fund for £200,000 and various other applications are in process as always...fingers crossed!

Generally, all going well and looking forward to seeing everyone in Aberdeen in July.
